

The first option I noticed was a battery backup and I definitely wanted that. There had been times where storms had taken out the power in my studio (10' door) and that while I could get up on a ladder and use the manual release to raise the door, it just wasn't worth it. My car remained trapped until the power came back on. Having a battery backup means that the garage door opener will still work even if the house loses power.


